






















This is a drawing with the development of the "Marina Dubai" zone






Finally, take a look at this rotating skyscraper....





This tower has a height of 250 meters and 59 floors mounted in a concrete core which will serve as a rotating shaft. The floors will be preassembled and then attached to the core of the building.

Each floor will rotate separate from the others. The velocity will be slow and not noticed by the residents.



The tower will have solar and aeolian electric system generators to be self-sufficient.

The project is Italian and has not begun yet. It is predicted that its construction, will last two and a half years.

The projected cost will be around 500 million dollars.
